6. 8 tablets antimalarial Artemether Lumefantrine (AL)
7. Paracetamol tablets
8. Sick child form

During your routine household visits, you came across the caregiver of Kerroly (a seven-month-old child) who complained to you about the unusual behaviour of Kerroly that could suggest she is feeling

unwell. As the Community Health Care Officer, you decided to give them a visit. Given that Kerroly has a malaria positive result, you are required to:

TASK 1: Use the child sick form provided and perform a clinical assessment on Kerroly.

TASK 2: Given that there is no danger sign recorded, conduct management of Kerroly at home.

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
