Positioned the client in a lateral recumbent (sims) position- either left or right sims position is acceptable:</p> <p>NB: The dorsal recumbent position is <u>not</u> equivalent to the lateral recumbent.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assigned one person responsibility for the lower legs and feet. • Assigned another person responsibility for the pelvis. • Assigned another person responsibility for the chest region and shoulders. • Ensured that all work is done in unison while maintaining the patient’s spine in neutral position. • Led the team to simultaneously pull the down-side hip and shoulder while pushing the up-side hip and shoulder. • Flexed the lower leg and placed padding between the legs. • Maintained the upper leg extended. • Protected the brachial plexus with padding. 	<p>22</p>		
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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extended the arms on double arm boards, or placed the down-side arm in front of the body. • Used a flank pad and a head stabilizer. • Confirmed that the patient is comfortable (asked this verbally). <p>NB: Confirm that incase a safety strap is used; it does cause excessive pressure on the patient’s skin/nerves.</p> <p><i>(award 2 marks for each correct action or 0; max 22)</i></p>
