TASK 1: SURGICAL HANDSCRUB			
1. Donned appropriate PPEs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surgical cap • Mackintosh • Theatre boots • Surgical mask • Goggles/face shield <i>(Award 1 mark for each or 0)</i>	5		
2. Removed jewelry (if present) prior to performing surgical hand antiseptis <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
3. Performed surgical hand scrub observing the laid down SOPs and dried hands using a sterile towel <i>(Award 2 marks or 0)</i>	2		
TASK 2: DONNING STERILE SURGICAL ATTIRE			
4. Donned the sterile gown appropriately: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reached for and lifted the folded gown directly upward. • Ensured the gown remained folded until stepping back from the gown table into unobstructed area. • Carefully located the gown's neckline and 	10		

<p>armholes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Held the inside front of the gown just at the armholes with both hands, let the gown unfold, keeping the inside of the gown toward the body and the hands in the armholes. • Extended both arms into the armholes simultaneously as the gown and its sleeves unfold. <p><i>(Award 2 marks for each of the above step to max 10 or 0)</i></p> <p><i>(Award full marks if gowning is done before gloving using the right technique)</i></p>			
<p>5. Requested the circulating personnel to securely tie at the waist first, followed by the neckline, leaving the cuffs of the sleeve extended over the hands.</p> <p><i>(Award 2 marks or 0)</i></p>	2		
<p>6. Donned sterile gloves appropriately:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Placed the sterile gloves in the paper wrapper on the surface in front of him/her like a book. • Picked up the glove for the dominant hand with the non-dominant hand by grasping the glove cuff, lifting straight up and placing it on the dominant palm • Peeled the cuff of the glove over the dominant cuffed hand, over the end of the sleeve. • Picked up the remaining glove using the gloved hand and placed it with the palm of the glove against the palm of the non-dominant hand and adjusted to fit. <p><i>(Award 2 marks for each of the above</i></p>	8

TASK 3: DOFFING SURGICAL ATTIRE			
7. Grasped the gown at the shoulders and pulled downward and forward, away from the body, turning the sleeves inside out. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
8. Rolled the gown so that the contaminated outside surface is contained inward. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
9. Disposed of the gown in a biohazard bag/receptacle/bin. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
10. Grasped one glove at the inner wrist, using the opposite gloved hand and pinched the cuff and pulled the glove off. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
11. Placed bare fingers inside the cuff of the opposite hand without touching the soiled glove and rolled it off the hand. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
12. Disposed waste appropriately after the task. e.g Used gloves in yellow bin <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1		
13. Performed a social hand wash. <i>(Award 1 mark or 0)</i>	1
