Performed surgical hand scrub appropriately <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turned on the water tap • Wet hands and lower forearms by holding them under running water • Applied enough soap to cover the hand surfaces • Wrapped hand palm to palm • Interlaced fingers while rubbing palm to palm and vice versa • Rubbed back of the fingers of opposing palm with fingers interlaced and vice versa • Performed rotational rubbing of the left 	12
