  - a) **Task 1:** Perform surgical hand scrub as per the WHO policy.
  - b) **Task 2:** Demonstrate correct use of instruments by draping the patient, prepping the skin, and handing over a blade, scissors, and a suture mounted to a needle holder.
2. You are provided with the following resources to carry out the tasks:
  - i. Simulated theatre room.
  - ii. Hand washing area with liquid antiseptic soap
  - iii. Full-body Mannequin
  - iv. Mask
  - v. Gloves
  - vi. Sterile gloves
  - vii. Gumboots
  - viii. Waste segregation area
  - ix. Needle holder
  - x. Scalpel
  - xi. Trolley
  - xii. Sterile pack (simulated) with kidney dish, needle holder, mosquito clips, scissors, gulli pot, sponge holding forceps
  - xiii. Sterile pack with large green towels (simulated)
  - xiv. Simulated surgeon
  - xv. Sterile gown (simulated)
  - xvi. Sterile gauze
  - xvii. Sterile hand towel
  - xviii. Suture

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
