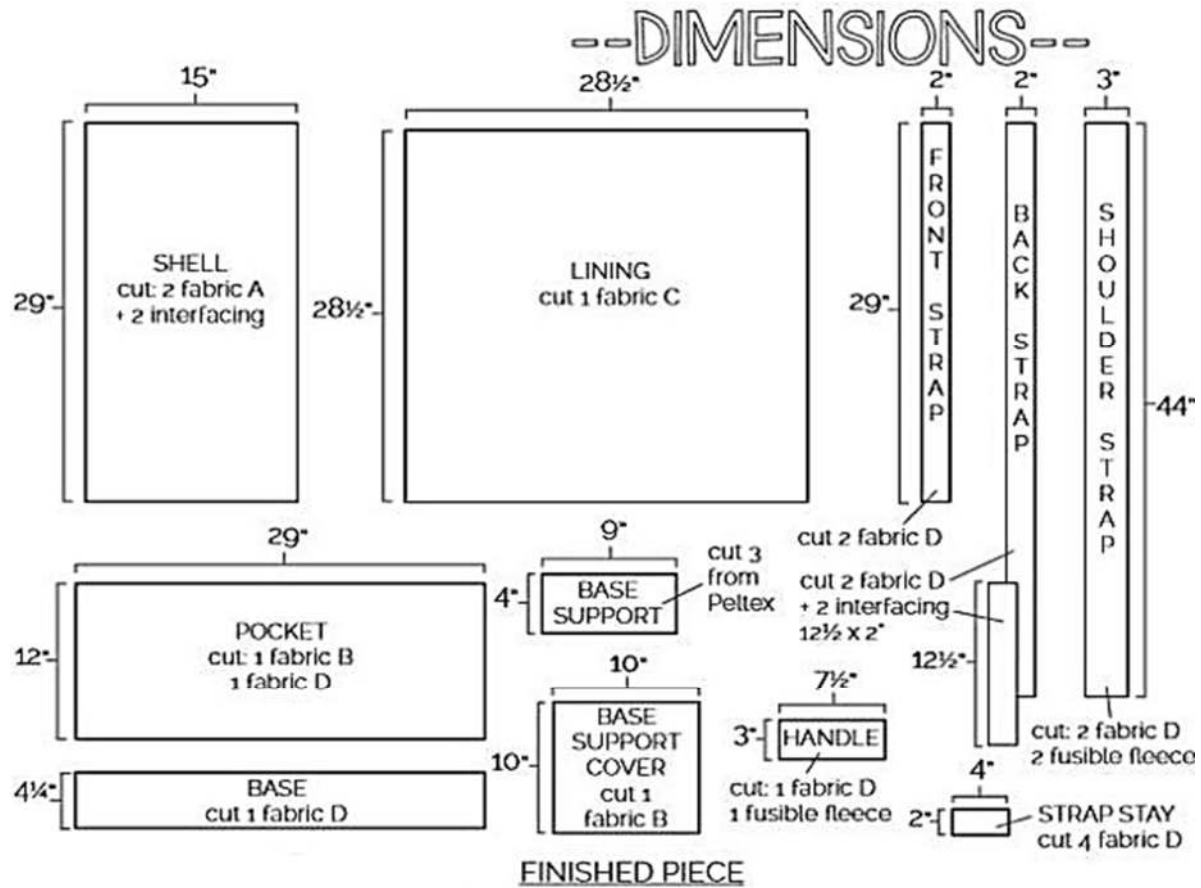
You are provided with the following software to perform the tasks:

TASK 1(25 Marks)

Using Adobe Illustrator or any other graphic design tools, design the provided **backbag** in fig 1 below using the dimensions provided.

Perform the following task

- a. Design the backbag phases with the dimensions specified and save as phases in CDACC folder
- b. Join the designed phases to come up with the designed backbag as shown in fig 1 above
- c. Design formatted text for branding as TVETCDACC with the logo of your choice
- d. Add the formatted branding in question c above to at least four sides of the backbag.
- e. Save the design as “MY BACKBAG” in the folder “TVETCDACC”.
- f. Print the design.

TASK 2: (25 Marks)

Using a graphic design tool provided, design a wedding card of Tom and Marry that will be on 10th August 2024 at Givenchy Gardens Nairobi.

Perform the following tasks

- g. Design both sides of the card
- h. Add text and images on both sides.
- i. Blend more than three colors on the design.
- j. Apply borders using vector graphics.
- k. Save as “MY WEDDING Card” in the folder “TVETCDACC”.
- l. Print both sides on one sheet.
