**Scenario**

A simulated hospital store has the following medical supplies in stock;

- III. Glucometers -18,
- IV. blood pressure machines (sphygmomanometers) – 20,
- V. Mercury thermometers- 01,
- VI. Adult patient gowns 56.

You receive the following items from supplier;

- I. Mercury thermometer 3
- II. Gloves 4 boxes
- III. Syringes 10 cc 2 boxes

You issue the following to male medical and paediatric wards as follows;

- i. Male medical ward: 3 boxes of gloves, 1 stethoscope, 1 Blood Pressure machine, and 4 patient gowns.
- ii. Paediatric ward: 3 mercury thermometers and 2 boxes of gloves.
